Practical Considerations Check Module Type: Ensure the 10G module is dual-rate (1G/10G) if you intend to connect it to a Gigabit port. Verify Port Support: Some SFP+ ports on 10G switches accept 1G SFP modules, but SFP ports on Gigabit switches generally cannot support 10G modules.
