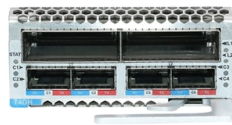

 - Protective Covers:** After fusion, fibers should be protected with heat-shrink sleeves or reinforced splice protectors to maintain mechanical strength and environmental resistance.
- Best Practices**
 - Fiber Preparation:** Strip 3–5 cm of the outer jacket and carefully remove the 250µm coating without bending the fiber.
 - Precision Cleaving:** Use a high-quality cleaver to produce flat, mirror-like fiber ends; poor cleaves can cause high loss or splice failure.
 - Splice Box Handling:** Place fibers gently in the V-grooves of the splicer, ensuring clamps are correctly positioned and covers are closed softly.
 - Quality Control:** Inspect splices under a microscope or use the splicer's built-in loss estimation...
