- Accessibility and Placement:** Distribution boards should be readily accessible for operation, maintenance, and inspection, typically mounted between 1 metre and 1.8 metres from the floor, with 1.3 metres recommended for elderly or handicapped users. Adequate working space must be provided around the panel to ensure safe access.
- Environmental Considerations:** Panels must be installed in dry, dust-free areas and protected from adverse environmental conditions. Outdoor installations require enclosures with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings to prevent water ingress and ensure durability.
- Electrical Design and Load Management:** The distribution box must be dimensioned to handle all circuits safely, with correct cable cross-sections, breaker sizes, and fuses. Planning for 20-30% spare capacity is recommended to accommodate future...
