- Install Bus Bars:** Mount neutral and ground bars inside the box. Connect the main neutral and ground wires to these bars.
- Install Individual Breakers:** Place single-pole or double-pole breakers for each circuit. Connect the output wires from each breaker to the respective load circuits.
- Connect Protective Devices:** If using RCDs or RCCBs, wire them according to the manufacturer's instructions to ensure leakage protection.
- Wire the Circuits:** Route phase wires from breakers, neutral wires to the neutral bus, and ground wires to the ground bus. Ensure all connections are tight and properly insulated.
- Label Circuits:** Clearly mark each breaker with the corresponding circuit or appliance for easy identification and maintenance.
- Test the System:** Before powering up, verify all connections, check for short circuits, and ensure breakers are in the off...
