The distribution box should accommodate future expansion, with sufficient space for additional breakers or circuits.

Safety and Protection Devices Distribution boxes must include circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors for each circuit to prevent overloads and short circuits. Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or Residual Current Breakers with Overcurrent Protection (RCBOs) provide protection against leakage currents. All metal parts, including the box, installation board, and appliance casings, must be properly grounded, and a protective neutral wire should be reliably connected.
