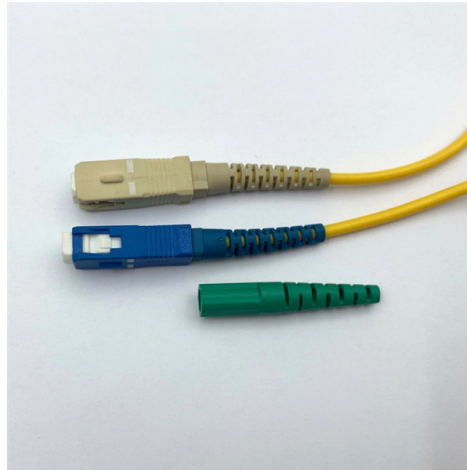

These labels should be placed on both side rails of all cable tray segments, with spacing not exceeding 15 meters (50 feet) for low-voltage or communication systems.
