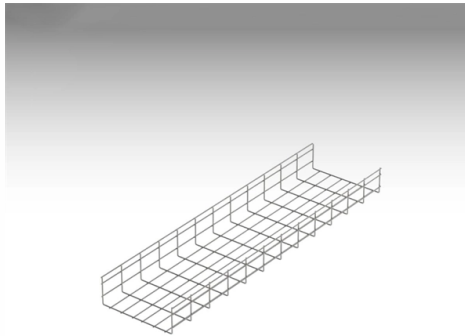

Insulation and Testing For high-voltage cables, especially XLPE-insulated types, it is essential to perform cable inner sheath insulation resistance tests and copper shielding layer resistance tests to verify integrity and prevent faults. If the metal shielding and armor layers are internally welded, these tests cannot be performed, so alternative measures like sectional insulation or cross-bonding are required. These tests help detect weak points in the cable that could lead to short circuits or insulation breakdown.

Grounding and Cross-Bonding Proper grounding is critical. For single-core high-voltage cables, the metal sheath should be grounded at one point, ensuring induced voltages do not exceed 50–100V. To minimize interference with adjacent cables, cross-bonding connections are recommended, with grounding through dedicated cross-bonding grounding boxes. Additionally, cable sheath protectors should be installed at ungrounded ends to prevent insulation damage.

Installation and Layout Considerations Distribution boxes should be installed in dry, well-ventilated areas away from corrosive environments to prevent overheating and equipment degradation. The box should be securely mounted, typically 1.5–1.8 meters above ground, to facilitate inspection and operation. Proper layout planning, including separating different voltage levels and strategically placing high-power and low-power circuits, reduces cable length, power loss, and risk of electrical faults.

Protective Devices To safeguard against electrical faults, distribution boxes should incorporate circuit breakers and relays appropriate for the system voltage and load. Options include MCBs, MCCBs, ACBs, VCBs, and SF₆ circuit break...
