

Cable tray horizontal turning techniques

1. These allow field customization of the bend angle. Installation involves marking the desired angle, cutting the tray if necessary, and attaching the splice plates with included hardware. Supports are required within 24 inches (600 mm) on both sides of the splice to ensure stability ().
3. Calculating Offsets and Bend Requirements: When a horizontal turn is needed to bypass obstacles, an offset calculation helps determine the required straight section length and bend angles. Tools and calculators can estimate the horizontal run, cut marks, and installation feasibility based on the total offset distance and desired angle. This ensures the tray maintains a continuous path without sharp bends that could damage cables ().

Installation Considerations

- Support Spacing:** Ensure proper support near bends and splice plates to prevent sagging or stress on the tray.
- Smooth Radius:** Use bends with smooth curves to facilitate cable pulling and reduce mechanical strain.
- Field Cutting:** If using adjustable bends, carefully mark and cut the tray, considering rung locations to avoid weakening the structure ().
- Hardware and Bonding:** Most adjustable splice plates come with hardware; bonding jumpers are typically not required.
