The latest NEC 2026 update requires a minimum of 12 inches of vertical clearance above cable trays for installation and maintenance access, with additional guidance provided by NEMA VE 1 and IEC 61537:2023 for proper tray support and spacing. NEC 2026 Requirements According to NEC Article 392, cable trays must maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above the tray to allow safe installation, inspection, and maintenance of conductors (NEC 392, 2026 update). Cable trays are prohibited in hoistways or enclosed spaces and must remain accessible. Metallic trays can serve as equipment grounding conductors if they meet NEC grounding requirements. The NEC also specifies fill limits: power cables should not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area, and control cables should not exceed 50%. High-power and low-power cables must be separated to prevent electromagnetic interference. NEMA VE 1 Guidelines NEMA VE 1 provides detailed guidance for metal cable tray systems, including ladder, ventilated, solid-bottom, and channel-type trays. It specifies load/span class designations, installation practices, and handling requirements. While NEMA does not prescribe a single height, it emphasizes adequate clearance for maintenance and safe cable support, harmonized with NEC requirements. Nonmetallic trays are covered under UL 568 and NEMA FG-1 standards, ensuring proper installation and performance in accordance with NEC rules. IEC 61537:2023 Standards The IEC 61537:2023 standard specifies requirements and tests for cable tray and ladder systems used to support electrical and communication cables. It provides guidance on tray arrangement, grouping of cables, and use as protective earth conductors. While IEC focuses on structural and functional requirements rather than a fixed clearance, it aligns with NEC and NEMA principles by ensuring safe access, proper support, and separation of cable types.
