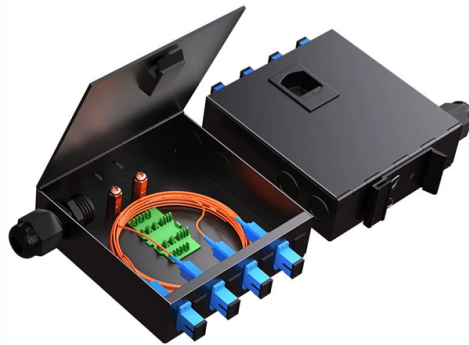


Can a single strand be used for the grounding wire of a distribution box
