

Can multimode fiber optic patch cords be used with single-mode optical modules



Overview

No, single-mode SFPs are designed to work with single-mode fiber cables and multimode SFPs are designed to work with multimode fiber cables. Compared to Multimode, Single-mode has a considerably smaller core. When we connect multimode SFP with single-mode fiber, only a fraction of the low-intensity LED emitted optical signal will get into the much narrower fiber core, but sure – some part, which will escape intense attenuation of.
