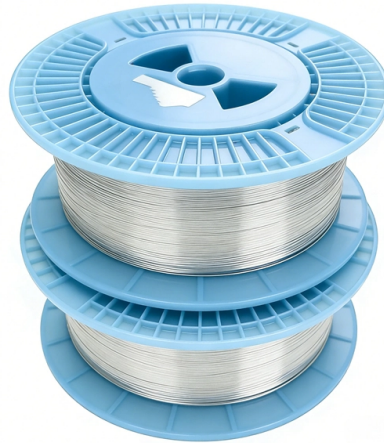


Can telecommunication towers be installed arbitrarily
