In a typical three-layer network, uplink ports play a key role in connecting switches across access, aggregation, and core layers. For example, the FS PicOS® S3410-24TS, used at the access layer, connects end-user devices and uses its 10G SFP+ uplinks to forward traffic to the PicOS® S5860-20SQ. Uplink Port on a Switch: vs Normal, Sizing & VLANs

On most switches the uplink is easy to spot: it is the port labeled "uplink," or the SFP/SFP+ ports set apart from the copper access ports, or simply the highest-speed ports on the unit.

Determine which port connects together switches

Check the ARP tables and see which ports have multiple MAC addresses in the ARP. You can then identify which switch that port goes to by seeing which switch has those addresses on

Ports Tab in Switch Dashboard

For a switch stack, faceplate of all the switches part of the stack is displayed. From the faceplate, click on the port to drill down and view port-level information.
