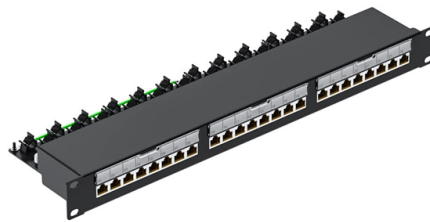


Classification Standards for the Sale of Optical Fiber Cables

Key Standards for Optical Fiber Classification

- ITU-T G.65x Series** The ITU-T G.65x recommendations define single-mode fiber types and their transmission characteristics. For example, G.652 is the baseline single-mode fiber optimized for 1310 nm, G.655 is non-zero dispersion-shifted fiber for DWDM systems, and G.657 specifies bend-insensitive fibers compatible with G.652. These standards ensure global interoperability and define optical properties such as attenuation, chromatic dispersion, and bending loss, which are critical for network performance and system design.
- IEC Standards** IEC 60793 specifies the optical fiber itself, including multimode (OM3/OM4) and single-mode fibers (G.652D, G.657). It defines bandwidth, attenuation, and other optical properties. IEC 60794 covers the finished cable assembly, including indoor (60794-2) and outdoor cables (60794-3), specifying mechanical and environmental performance such as tensile strength, crush resistance, and temperature tolerance. IEC 60332 addresses fire and safety compliance, ensuring cables meet flammability and halogen-free requirements.
- ISO/IEC 11801** This standard defines generic cabling for customer premises, including performance classes for multimode (OM3, OM4) and single-mode (OS2) fibers. It provides pass/fail criteria for connector quality, insertion loss, and other installation parameters, which are essential for system integrators and data centers.
- TIA Standards** The TIA-568.3-D standard specifies optical fiber cabling for commercial buildings, including testing methods, fiber types, and installation practices. TIA stan...
