

Coaxial Optical Cable Connector Fabrication

The manufacturing of coaxial optical cable connectors involves precise layering of conductors, dielectric insulation, shielding, and outer jackets, followed by connector assembly and rigorous testing to ensure signal integrity and mechanical reliability.

Core Conductor Preparation The process begins with the inner conductor, typically made of copper or copper-coated aluminum for electrical coaxial cables, or a fiber optic core for optical coaxial cables. For electrical cables, copper rods are drawn into fine wires with diameters ranging from 0.2 to 2 mm, ensuring high conductivity and uniformity. In optical cables, the fiber core is drawn from preforms using fiber drawing towers, maintaining precise diameter and optical clarity.

Dielectric Insulation A dielectric layer is extruded around the conductor to maintain spacing and signal integrity. Materials such as polyethylene (PE), foam PE, or PTFE are used, with thickness controlled to ± 0.1 mm tolerances. In optical coaxial cables, the dielectric may include a polymer coating that protects the fiber and maintains concentricity.

Shielding Application The next step is shielding, which reduces electromagnetic interference (EMI) in electrical coaxial cables. This can be a combination of aluminum foil and braided copper, with braid coverage typically around 90%. For optical coaxial cables, metallic shielding may be applied for hybrid designs or to protect against mechanical stress, while maintaining optical signal integrity.

Outer Jacket Extrusion An outer protective jacket is extruded over the shielding. Materials like PVC, PE, or LSZH provide mechanical protection, environmental resistance, and flexibility. Jacket thickness is precisely controlled, usually within ± 0.2 mm, to balance durability and flexibility.
