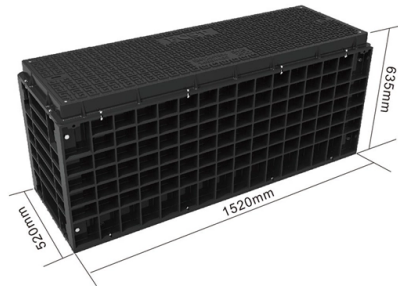

- Conduit pulling:** Fiber cables are pulled through the conduit using a swivel and pulling line to prevent twisting and maintain the minimum bend radius.
