

Concrete type for distribution box foundation



Overview

A box foundation is a load-bearing foundation, usually made of reinforced concrete, with a box-shaped cross-section. It is used when large vertical loads, horizontal forces and moments must be safely transferred into the subsoil while deformations, settlements and vibrations are to be limited.
