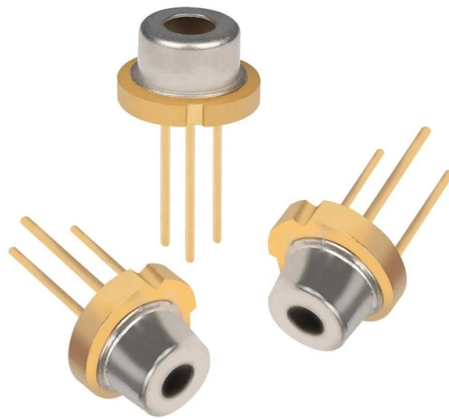

IP and NEMA Ratings: Switches and enclosures are selected based on environmental exposure. For dry indoor areas, standard IP ratings (e.g., IP20-IP44) are sufficient, while outdoor or wet conditions require higher protection (IP54-IP69) or NEMA 4X enclosures.

Load Balancing: Many temporary distribution boxes include metering or counters to monitor consumption per circuit. This allows for symmetrical load distribution and prevents overloading of any single phase.
