

Configure the switch via network cable connection

You can configure a network switch by connecting it to your computer using a console cable, accessing the CLI, and setting up basic network parameters like hostname, IP address, and interface settings.

Step 1: Prepare the Physical Connection

Console Cable Connection: Connect one end of a console cable (serial or USB-to-serial) to your computer and the other end to the switch's console port. If your PC lacks a serial port, use a USB-to-serial adapter.

Power On the Switch: Ensure the switch is connected to a power source and turned on. Wait for the boot process to complete and observe any startup messages on your terminal software.

Step 2: Launch Terminal Emulation Software

Open software like PuTTY, Tera Term, or HyperTerminal on your computer. Configure the connection to the appropriate COM port and set the baud rate to 9600 (common default for most switches). Click "Open" to access the switch's CLI.

Step 3: Access the CLI and Enter Configuration Mode

Press Enter to reach the CLI prompt. Enter privileged EXEC mode by typing enable and pressing Enter. The prompt changes from > to #. Enter global configuration mode with configure terminal or config t to make system-wide changes.

Step 4: Basic Switch Configuration

Set Hostname: hostname Switch1 to identify the switch on your network.

Configure Interfaces: CodeCopyinterface ip address no shutdown This assigns an IP address and activates the interface.

Set Default Gateway: ip default-gateway to allow communication outside the local network.

Step 5: Connect Devices via Ethernet

Use standard Ethernet cables to connect the switch to your router or other network devices. Connect a LAN port on the router to any port on the switch to expand network connectivity. Connect additional devices to the switch ports to provide internet access and local network communication.
