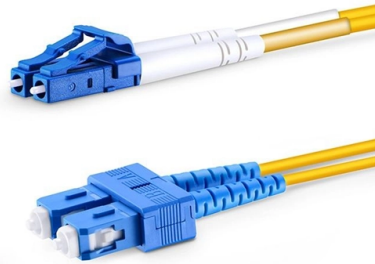


Connection between distribution box and power supply line

Overview of Distribution Box Function

A distribution box (DB), also known as a distribution board, is the central point where electrical power is divided into multiple circuits for different loads. It contains protective devices such as Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs), Residual Current Circuit Breakers (RCCBs), and sometimes isolating switches to ensure safety and control over the electrical system. The DB receives power from a main supply line, which can be single-phase (common in domestic setups) or three-phase (used in commercial or industrial installations).

Incoming Power Line

The incoming line to the distribution box is the main power supply, typically connected to a main MCB or main switch. In single-phase domestic systems, this consists of a phase and neutral wire, while in three-phase systems, three phase wires and a neutral are used. The main MCB acts as the first line of protection, controlling the flow of electricity into the DB. In some setups, a dual power switch may be installed to allow automatic switching to a backup supply in case of a power failure.

Outgoing Power Lines

From the distribution box, outgoing lines are routed to individual circuits or loads. Each outgoing line is connected to a single-pole or double-pole MCB, which protects the circuit from overloads and short circuits. For sensitive or high-risk circuits, an RCCB is used to detect leakage currents and prevent electric shocks. The configuration ensures that each load receives a reliable and protected power supply, and faults in one circuit do not affect others.
