

Core Switch Configuration Tips

Initial Setup

Connect to the Switch Console: Use a terminal emulator like PuTTY to connect via a serial console or SSH/Telnet if the switch is already networked. Set the correct COM port and baud rate (commonly 9600 or 115200) to access the CLI.

Enter Privileged EXEC Mode: Type `enable` to access privileged mode, then enter Global Configuration Mode with `configure terminal`.

Set Hostname and Domain Name: Assign a unique hostname for identification and configure the domain name for SSH key generation.

Configure Management IP: Assign an IP address to the management VLAN to allow remote administration. Set a default gateway if the switch needs to communicate outside its subnet.

Secure Access: Configure passwords for console, VTY (Telnet/SSH), and enable secret passwords. Optionally, integrate with AAA servers for centralized authentication.

VLAN and Port Configuration

Create VLANs: Define VLANs for network segmentation using `vlan` and assign names for clarity.

Assign Ports: Configure access ports with `switchport mode access` and trunk ports with `switchport mode trunk` and `switchport trunk encapsulation dot1q` if needed.

Verify VTP Settings: Set the VTP domain and ensure the revision number is correct to prevent overwriting VLAN configurations from other switches.

Advanced Core Switch Considerations

Module and Slot Configuration: Core switches often have multiple slots for interface and function modules. Choose modules (LAN, WAN, SFP, 10Gbps) based on network requirements to ensure scalability.

Backplane Bandwidth: Ensure the switch backplane can handle the expected inter-port traffic. Higher bandwidth reduces bottlenecks and improves data exchange speed.

Redundancy and High Availability: Implement HSRP or VRRP for gateway redundancy. Configure dual aggregation and three-layer routing to mai...
