Cooling Requirements: Temperature Control: Ensure that the room is equipped with adequate cooling systems, such as precision air conditioning units designed for IT environments. This is crucial for maintaining consistent temperature and humidity levels.

Airflow Management: Proper positioning of racks and the use of raised floors can enhance airflow, helping to prevent overheating.

Future Growth: Plan for Expansion: Always reserve 15-20% of your space for future growth or reconfiguration. This includes additional rack space, power outlets, and network ports to accommodate evolving technology needs.

Organization and Maintenance: Cable Management: Organize cables and equipment neatly to improve airflow and facilitate maintenance. Proper organization reduces the risk of accidental disconnections and enhances overall efficiency.
