- Static Pressure:** Consider the resistance caused by filters, louvers, or ducting. Fans must overcome this pressure to maintain airflow.
- Environment:** For dusty or humid environments, choose fans with protective grills or filters to prevent contamination and ensure longevity.

- Select slightly higher CFM than calculated to account for fan aging and dust accumulation.
- Regular maintenance extends fan life and ensures consistent cooling.
- Match fan voltage and enclosure design to avoid electrical or mechanical issues.
