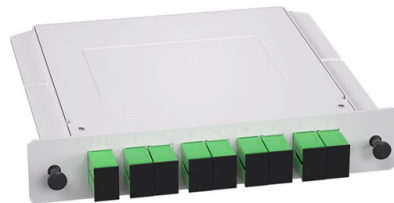


Disassembling the fiber optic router

Tweezers for handling small connectors and cables. Rubber safety caps for fiber optic connectors and transceivers. Optional: Anti-static wrist strap and mat for ESD protection. Before disassembly, power off the router and disconnect all cables. Label or photograph connections to aid reassembly.

Disassembly Steps

Open the Router Casing: Remove all visible screws and gently pry apart the plastic clips. Take care not to force the casing, which can crack or damage internal components.

Identify Fiber Optic Connections: Locate the fiber optic transceiver and cable. Most home routers use SC or SC/APC connectors.

Disconnect Fiber Optic Cables: Press the release mechanism or gently pull the connector straight out. Immediately cover the transceiver and cable ends with rubber caps to prevent contamination and laser exposure.

Handle Internal Components: Avoid touching the PCB traces, connector pins, or chips directly. If any adhesive or anti-static tape comes loose, it can be replaced with painter's tape to prevent short circuits.
