Standard Cable Tray Lengths Cable trays are manufactured in standard lengths to simplify transport and installation. Common lengths include 3 meters (10 feet) for most indoor installations, which is manageable for handling and shipping, while some manufacturers offer 12, 20, 24, 30, or even 40-foot sections for long-span or outdoor applications. The choice of tray length depends on the installation environment, load requirements, and the need to minimize the number of joints or supports. Support Span and Distance The support span is the distance between two supports holding the tray. Proper support spacing is critical for structural integrity and safety: Short-span trays (typically indoor, non-industrial) are supported every 6 to 8 feet. Intermediate-span trays are supported every 10 to 12 feet. Long-span trays can be supported at 14 to 20-foot intervals, with 20 feet being common for outdoor or heavy-duty installations. Extra-long spans may exceed 20 feet, often used to cross roads or reduce the number of expensive supports. The tray length must always be equal to or longer than the chosen support span to ensure stability. Splice plates are used to connect tray sections, and their placement becomes more critical in long-span installations. Horizontal and Vertical Spacing When installing multiple trays in parallel or in stacked configurations: Horizontal spacing between trays should be at least 0.6 meters to allow maintenance, inspection, and proper airflow for heat dissipation. Power and signal trays should maintain a minimum separation of 0.5 meters, which can be reduced to 0.3 meters if the trays are shielded to minimize electromagnetic interference. Vertical spacing between floor-mounted trays should be at least 150 millimeters, and the top of the tray should maintain a minimum distance of 0.3 meters from the ceiling or obstructions.
