Consistent format: Include both the distribution box number and the circuit number on each breaker or fuse. Update regularly: Labels should reflect any changes in wiring or circuit assignments. Safety compliance: Follow local electrical codes (e.g., NEC) and ensure each circuit has its own breaker or fuse.
