Integration with Circuit Numbering: Circuits fed from a panel are often labeled with a prefix of the panel number, creating a consistent system for identifying both the panel and its branch circuits .

Standard Numbering Practices

Electrical Identification Number: Each switchboard, motor control center (MCC), or distribution board is assigned a unique number, often alphanumeric, e.g., P410 for a main LV switchboard .

Circuit References: Branch circuits are numbered using the panel number as a prefix, e.g., P410-C1 for the first circuit from panel P410 .

Master Tag List: Numbers are usually derived from a master tag list maintained in engineering software or plant documentation to ensure consistency across all electrical equipment .

For a low-voltage switchboard labeled DB-01: The panel itself is DB-01. Circuits fed from this panel might be labeled DB-01-01, DB-01-02, etc. This system allows anyone reading the schematic or working on-site to quickly identify t...
