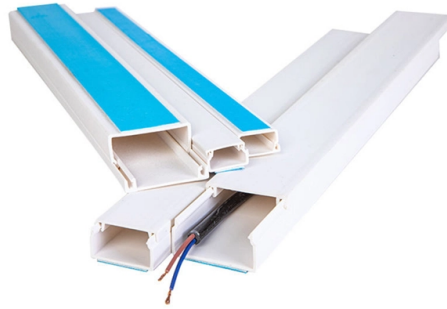

- Keep it away from water, flammable, explosive, or corrosive substances.
- Ensure proximity to the main power supply for easier connection.
- Verify the IP/NEMA rating for indoor or outdoor use and check the load capacity to match your home's electrical demand.

Wiring and Assembly Steps

- Turn off the main power before starting any work.
- Mount the box securely on the wall using appropriate fasteners.
- Install the main breaker and connect it to the incoming power line.
- Connect the neutral and grounding bars to the main supply.
- Install individual circuit breakers for lighting, outlets, and appliances.
- Route and connect wires neatly to each breaker, ensuring correct wire gauge and insulati...
