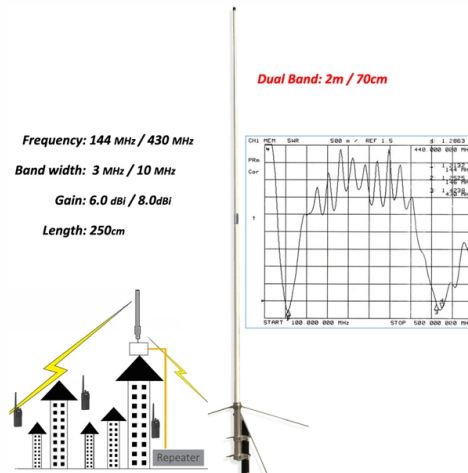


Electrical distribution box in the unit
