- 4. Sealing and Protection** Route cables through explosion-proof cable glands to maintain enclosure integrity (). Close the terminal chamber cover and secure it with fasteners, ensuring the flameproof joints are not scratched or damaged (). For outdoor installations, fit a rain cover to prevent water ingress and rust ().
- 5. Testing and Verification** After wiring, verify all connections and grounding before en...
