Overview

AT&T developed and licensed the ST (Straight Tip) fiber connector shortly after introducing the FC type. It features a bayonet mount and a long cylindrical 2.5mm ceramic ferrule to retain the fiber. It's primarily used in legacy systems, industrial applications, and certain military-grade networks. While less common in modern networks, ST connectors are still in use where robust. A fiber optic connector is a mechanical device that allows two fibers to be joined precisely, enabling light to pass with minimal insertion loss and reflection. Because ST is spring-loaded, you must ensure that it is correctly seated. Similar to the FC, the index tab must be carefully aligned with a slot when insertion. 25 mm ceramic ferrule—half the diameter of legacy SC/ST/FC ferrules—so LC enables significantly higher port density and is widely used where. In the fiber vernacular it is a simplex bayonet-style twist-lock connector.
