Signal Management: It supports passive optical splitters (1:4, 1:8, or up to 1:16) to divide the optical signal efficiently across multiple rooms while maintaining minimal signal loss.

Connectivity: Typically, the panel base provides ports for LC-APC connectors and single-mode fibers, aligning with modern EU and international standards for gigabit-capable networks.

Capacity: Many FTTR panel bases can handle connections for up to 16 sub-gateways or endpoints, allowing scalable deployment in multi-unit residential or commercial buildings.

Integration with FTTR Devices

Main Gateway: The panel base connects to the FTTR main gateway, which interfaces with the GPON/XGS-PON uplink and provides core network services.

Sub-Gateways/Slave ONTs: From the panel base, optical signals are routed to sub-gateways or slave ONTs installed in each room, delivering gigabit speeds and Wi-Fi 6/7 coverage.

Star Topology: The recommended network topology is a star configuration—main gateway → panel base → optical splitters → room ONTs—ensuring stable throughput and minimal latency.
