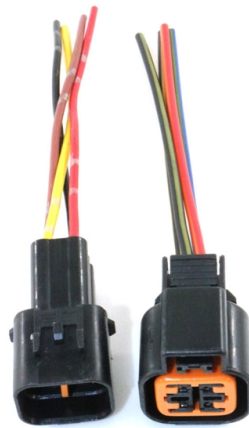


Fiber Optic Cable Entry Procedure

Step 1: Checking Availability and Planning Before installation, confirm that fiber service is available in your area. Step 3: Fiber Cable Installation

Underground Installation Conduits and Trenching: Fiber cables are pulled through conduits buried typically 12–48 inches deep, depending on urban or rural conditions, soil type, and traffic.

Cable Types: Loose tube and armored fiber cables are preferred for underground use due to moisture resistance and mechanical protection.

Pulling and Splicing: Cables are carefully pulled to avoid exceeding bend radius or tension limits. Sections are spliced to create continuous connections, ensuring minimal signal loss.

Aerial Installation Fiber is strung along utility poles using pulleys and tensioners, secured with clamps and spacers. This method is faster and less disruptive, commonly used in suburban or rural areas.

Step 4: In-Home Setup Once the fiber reaches the property, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is installed inside or just outside the home. The ONT converts light signals from the fiber into electrical data for your network. A router or gateway then distributes this data to devices via Wi-Fi or Ethernet.
