- 2. Mechanical Splicing:** Aligns fibers using a mechanical fixture with index-matching gel or fluid to reduce loss and reflections. Easier to install with minimal tools, but typical losses are around 0.5 dB. Often used for multimode fibers or small-scale installations where fusion splicing is not cost-effective.

Experimental Procedure

Fiber Preparation: Strip the outer jacket and buffer layers to expose the fiber core. Clean the fiber with isopropyl alcohol to remove debris.

Cleaving: Use a fiber cleaver to create a flat, perpendicular end face for optimal splicing.

Alignment: Place fibers in the splicer's vee-groove and align them precisely under the electrode...
