3. **Bend Radius and Physical Protection:** Maintain a minimum bend radius of 400mm for all fiber patch cords to prevent signal attenuation and physical damage. Avoid sharp bends, kinks, or hanging cords between multiple spools.
4. **Color Coding and Labeling:** Use color-coded connectors and cables to distinguish fiber types, core diameters, and network segments. Proper labeling at both ends of the patch cord ensures quick identification and reduces errors during moves, adds, or changes (MACs).
5. **Matching Fiber Specifications:** Ensure patch cords match the trunk cable in core diameter and mode field diameter. Single-mode fibers should be paired with single-mode cords, and multimode fibers with multimode cords. Using mismatched fibers can cause significant signal loss.
6. **Cable Management Accessories:** Utilize vertical and horizontal cable management channels, spools, or retractable patch cable systems to maintain neatness, optimize airflow, and maximize rack space. Structured pathways prevent tangling and facilitate easier m...
