

Fiber optic cable can be split into three routers



Overview

Fiber optic connections can't be shared across multiple devices without the proper networking equipment. A fiber optic splitter is a passive optical component that divides a single incoming optical signal into two or more outgoing signals, or combines multiple incoming signals into one. Unlike active devices (which require power), splitters operate without electricity, relying solely on the physics of. For a small fee (the procurement of the modules and the circulator) you can split/splice one physical fibre optic cable into multiple pairs. The downside is that once you loose your one-and-only fibre link (to a cable-hunting-buck-hoe) then you're in trouble. Splitters come in various configurations, such as 1x2, 1x4, or 1x8, depending on how many splits are needed.
