1. Active Connection (Plug-and-Play) This method uses pre-terminated connectors to quickly connect fibers to devices or patch panels. It is flexible, convenient, and reliable, commonly used in network cabling. Typical attenuation is around 1 dB per connection, and while some light loss occurs, it allows easy reconfiguration.
2. Field-Installable Connectors For custom installations, connectors can be attached on-site: Strip the fiber cable to expose the bare fiber. Clean the fiber with alcohol wipes to remove dust or residue. Use a fiber cleaver to make a precise, flat cut. Insert the fiber into the connector, aligning it with the ferrule. Secure the connector using a crimping tool or adhesive, depending on the type. Test the connection with a visual fault locator (VFL) or optical power meter to ensure minimal loss.
3. Fusion Splicing Fusion splicing permanently joins two fibers by melting their ends together using a fusion splicer. This method provides the lowest signal loss (0.01–0.03 dB) and is ideal for long-distance or permanent connections. Steps include: Strip and clean the fiber ends. Cleave the fibers precisely. Align the fibers in the splicer and fuse them using an electric arc. Protect the splice in a special container.
4. Mechanical or Cold Splicing Mechanical splicing uses sleeves or clamps to hold fiber ends together. It is quick and reliable for temporary connections, with t...
