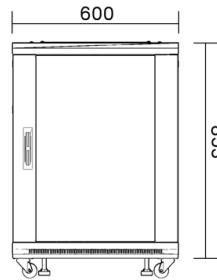

3. SkyWrap: SkyWrap is a commercial implementation of wrapped OPAC. It is designed for fast, cost-effective installation with minimal additional load on towers and conductors. It is particularly useful in difficult terrain, over rivers, or in areas where other installation methods are impractical.

For all fiber trunk cables and fiber jumpers, which do not run in con-duit, we recommend fixing them at intervals of 0,80 -1 meter vertically and 1 meter horizontally.
