- Limit connected devices and close unnecessary apps or automatic updates that consume bandwidth .
- Update router firmware and check for configuration errors or IP conflicts .
- Run a speed test to compare actual speeds with your plan and identify if the issue is with your ISP .

By systematically checking these factors, you can often restore your fiber connection to its expected high-speed performance.
