

Fiber optic cable to router cable conversion

You cannot plug a fiber optic cable directly into a standard router; you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) or a media converter to convert the optical signal into an electrical signal that the router can use. Understanding the Conversion

Fiber optic cables transmit data using light pulses, while standard routers use electrical signals over Ethernet cables. Because of this difference, a direct connection is not possible. The optical signal must first be converted into an electrical signal that the router can interpret.

Using an Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

Connect the Fiber Cable: Plug the fiber optic cable into the ONT's designated optical port, usually labeled "Fiber" or "GPON".

Power the ONT: Connect the ONT to a power source and wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a successful connection.

Link to Router: Use a Cat5e or higher Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port.

Power the Router: Turn on the router and verify that the connection is active via the router's indicator lights.

Using a Media Converter or SFP Module

If you do not have an ONT, you can use a media converter or a router with SFP/SFP+ ports.

Media Converter: This device bridges the fiber optic cable to an Ethernet cable. Connect the fiber cable to the converter's fiber port, then connect the converter's Ethernet port to the router's WAN port.

SFP/SFP+ Module: Some routers and switches have SFP ports. Insert a compatible SFP transceiver for your fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode), then plug the fiber cable into the SFP module. The router can then receive the converted electrical signal directly.

Connector Types: Ensure the fiber cable connector (LC, SC, ST) matches the ONT or SFP module port.
