Fiber optic cables include built-in strength members to handle tension and compression, especially during installation in underground utilities or when deployed across long distances. Each optical cable is constructed using a precise combination of optical fibers, strength members, buffer tubes. An armored optical cable is a type of fiber optic cable reinforced with a protective layer—usually corrugated steel tape (STA) or steel wires (SWA)—to shield the internal fibers from external threats such as crushing, rodent bites, moisture, and harsh installation conditions.
