These ports are usually labeled "SFP," "SFP+," or "Fiber" and may require a specific module type (e.g., LC, SC) to match the fiber cable. When using an SFP+ ONU stick provided by your ISP, the SFP+ port on the router can serve as the WAN interface for fiber internet. Identifying the Correct Port Look for labels such as "Fiber," "FTTH," "PON," "SFP," or "WAN" on the back or side of the router. If your router does not have an SFP port, the fiber cable must connect to the ONT, and the router receives the signal via its WAN/Ethernet port. Some routers may hide the fiber port behind a panel, so consult the device manual if necessary. Summary Standard home setup: Fiber cable → ONT → Ethernet cable → Router WAN port. Router with SFP/SFP+ support: Fiber cable → SFP/SFP+ port on router (with compatible module).
