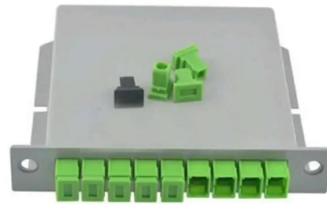

- Attachment Mechanism:** Coupling methods such as push-pull, bayonet, screw-on, or snap-in that secure the connector to another connector or device.
- Boots:** Protective covers that prevent fiber bending and damage at the cable entry point.

Types of Connectors Common fiber optic connector types include:

- SC (Subscriber Connector):** Square-shaped, push-pull mechanism, widely used in FTTH and data centers.
- LC (Lucent Connector):** Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25mm ferrule, ideal for high-density applications.
- ST (Straight Tip):** Bayonet-style connector, often used in legacy networks.
- MPO/MTP:** Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications in data centers.

Connectors are available for single-mode and multimode fibers, with different core sizes and performance characteristics.
