Main Optical Cable Splicing Fiber optic splicing is the process of joining two fiber optic cables to create a continuous optical path. It is essential when cable runs exceed standard lengths, when connecting different fiber types, or when repairing damaged cables. There are two main splicing methods:

- Mechanical Splicing:** Fibers are aligned and held together using an index-matching gel. This method is quick, temporary, and typically has a loss of around 0.3 dB. It is useful for short-term connections or rapid restoration.
- Fusion Splicing:** Fibers are permanently joined using heat or an electric arc, producing a low-loss connection (~ 0.1 dB) with minimal back reflection. Fusion splicing is preferred for permanent installations and long-haul networks. Splicing is usually performed on main optical cables (trunk cables) before connecting to patch...
