Firestop Mastics and Sealants: Use intumescent or ablative sealants to fill smaller gaps around cable trays, ensuring a continuous barrier. Certified Fireproof Pillows: Products like AF BAGS are intumescent and ablative pillows certified under EN 1366-3 for up to EI 240 fire resistance. They are suitable for cable diameters up to 21 mm and can be inserted into thin walls without additional framing.
