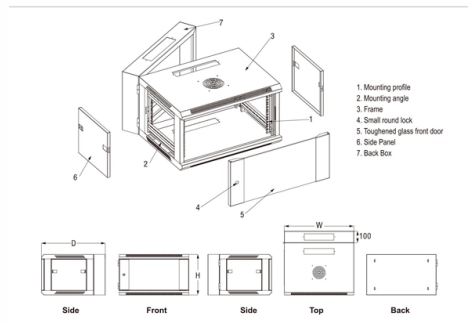


# Fireproofing requirements for cable tray construction



## AI Overview

Cable trays must be fireproofed using UL-listed firestop systems, fire-resistant coatings, and proper sealing techniques to prevent fire and smoke propagation while maintaining cable functionality.

**Firestop and Sealing Requirements** Cable trays passing through walls, floors, or slabs must have all openings tightly sealed with firestopping materials to prevent fire spread . Key requirements include:

- Firestop Materials:** Use fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, or fire-resistant mineral wool .
- Packing and Gaps:** Firestop packs should be placed in sequence, with gaps between packs and cables not exceeding 1 cm<sup>2</sup>, and packing thickness at least 24 cm .
- Backing Plates:** For large openings, install a fire-resistant backing plate before sealing .
- Cover Plates:** Ensure cover plates are square, evenly painted, and fully close the opening .
- Waterstop:** At slab penetrations, provide a waterstop of at least 50 mm in height .

For specific UL-listed systems, such as 3M firestop pillows and moldable putty, the number of pillows and putty sticks depends on tray size and wall type, with concrete walls requiring up to 3-hour F-rating and gypsum walls up to 2-hour F-rating .

**Fire-Resistant Materials and Coatings** Cable trays themselves can be protected using fire-resistant coatings and tapes:

- FLAMMOTECT-A Coating:** Forms a protective shield around cables, preventing flame propagation and maintaining functionality during fire .
- DG-CR 0.7 Fire Protection Tape:** Provides additional fire resistance and environmental protection against UV, moisture, and chemicals .
- Intumescent Caulks:** Expand under heat to seal gaps and block heat penetration .

Tray materials should also be selected based on environment: painted or galvanized steel for indoor use, hot-dip galvanized or stainless steel for outdoor, and aluminum or fiberglass-reinforced plastic for corrosive or high-humidity areas .
