A four-level distribution box on a construction site is a modular electrical system designed to safely distribute power through multiple protection and control layers, extending the standard three-level system with an additional sub-distribution layer.

Structure and Levels

A typical construction site distribution system is designed to provide progressive protection and control for electrical equipment:

- Main Distribution Level (Level 1):** This is the primary cabinet where incoming power enters. It usually features a main busbar, measuring systems, and a main switch. The enclosure is often rainproof and suitable for outdoor use, complying with construction electricity standards (IEC 61439, IEC 60364) to ensure safety and durability.
- Secondary Distribution Level (Level 2):** Installed under the main cabinet, this level distributes power to different zones or major equipment. It typically has inner and outer doors, a spray-painted exterior, and a rainproof top. It provides additional protection and aesthetic appeal while maintaining safety.
- Tertiary Distribution Level (Level 3):** This level consists of final junction boxes for individual electrical appliances. It can be fixed or movable and includes leakage protection switches to prevent electrical hazards. Each appliance is connected downstream of this level to ensure safety.
- Quaternary Distribution Level (Level 4):** The fourth level is an additional sub-distribution layer, often used in large or complex construction sites. It further divides power to smaller circuits or specialized equipment, maintaining the same protection principles as the previous levels. This level ensures that high-demand or sensitive equipment receives stable and protected power.

Enclosure Materials: Commonly sheet steel, thermoplastic, fiberglass, or polyester, with internal doors made of 1.2mm sheet steel.
