 - Alarm Button:** Triggers an audible alert to notify building personnel of an emergency.
 - Emergency Stop:** Immediately halts elevator movement in case of malfunction or danger.
 - Call for Help / Intercom:** Connects passengers to security or emergency services.
- 5. Service and Special Function Buttons:**
 - Firefighter Operation:** Allows emergency personnel to control the elevator during a fire.
 - Independent Service / Service Mode:** Used for maintenance, moving heavy items, or special operations. These often require a key or code.
 - Hold Button:** Keeps doors open longer, commonly found in hotels or hospitals.
