Ensure trays are level, straight, and aligned, using connectors and fittings to maintain structural integrity. Center-hung supports can speed up installation and facilitate cable placement. Installation Procedure Route Planning: Mark the tray path considering clearance, load, and separation from other services. Tray Assembly: Connect sections using approved fittings, ensuring proper alignment and secure fastening. Cable Pulling: Lay cables carefully to avoid damage, maintaining proper spacing and avoiding overcrowding. Bonding and Grounding: Metallic trays must be grounded per Article 250.96, and the tray can serve as an Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC). Use grounding clamps to bond tray sections and EGCs, avoiding bare copper in aluminum trays to prevent corrosion. Safety and Maintenance Handle trays carefully during offloading and installation to prevent injury or damage. Use cranes or forklifts cautiously, lifting single bundles at a time and avoiding attachment to tray siderails. Proper installation facilitates future maintena...
