 - OM3: 10 Gbps up to 1000 ft, aqua/cyan jacket.
 - OM4: 10 Gbps up to 1300 ft, 40/100 Gbps up to 500 ft, aqua/purple jacket.
 - OM5: Supports short wavelength division multiplexing, up to 200–400 Gbps, similar distances to OM4, lime green jacket.

Indoor vs. Outdoor Cables

- Indoor cables:** Typically have white or yellow jackets, designed for installation inside walls or ceilings.
- Outdoor cables:** Black jackets, water-resistant, UV-resistant, and suitable for direct burial or external routing.

Connectors and Construction

Common connectors include LC, SC, ST, and MTP/MPO depending on space and device compatibility. Fiber cables have a glass core, surrounded by cladding, a primary plastic coating, and often additional strengthening fibers for durability. Household cables are usually tight-buffered for easier handling and installation.

- Environment:** Indoor vs. outdoor, considering exposure to moisture or sunlight.
